## OUR NAMESAKE

The Tailwaggers Foundation's name pays homage to the Tailwaggers Club, a charity created in 1929.

Bette Davis put the organization on the map when she was elected as president of Southern California's branch. Her dedication to animal welfare was a powerful force for raising awareness. LIFE magazine covered one of her fund raising events, which enlisted the support of generous donors like Howard Hughes and Walt Disney. By 1930, The Tailwaggers Club had almost a million members worldwide.



Tailwaggers Pet Food and Supplies was founded by Todd Warner in 2003.
Inspired by the profound influence of dogs and cats on his life and the Tailwaggers team, Todd aimed to give back. In 2013, the Tailwaggers
Foundation was reinstated with the help of loyal customers and supporters, and it continues to proudly thrive today.

## How we give grants

Most animal rescue organizations spend 50% of their budget alone to medically treat sick and injured animals. The rescues simply do not have the budget to treat all the animals that come through their doors. In many cases, bringing an injured dog or cat back to a state of health can be the difference between finding them a new home or euthanasia.

Non-profits working on the front lines rescuing animals can apply for a grant on behalf of animals that have undergone medical treatment. The Tailwaggers Foundation board members review submissions and recipients receive a cash contribution towards their medical bills.
